Dr Moreea was appointed as a Consultant Gastroenterologist/Hepatologist in 2004. He has developed the Hepatology service in Bradford which is the second largest centre for treating hepatitis B and C in the region.

He has consolidated the haemochromatosis service and has started the only dedicated day case paracentesis service in the region.

Dr Moreea's interest, apart from viral hepatitis, is in the formation of endoscopists in developing countries – he has helped set up endoscopy units in Mauritius and St Lucia.

He will provide an update on the recently revised guidelines on managing abnormal liver function tests in primary care. He will also present on the diagnosis and management of cirrhosis and its complications.
